## **Button Quail Care Guidelines**

## **Incubation of Eggs**

• Temperature: 99.5 degrees

• Humidity: 50-60%

• Duration: 16 days incubation

## **Live Care**

- Quail need heat to maintain a temperature of 99.5
  degrees for up to 3 weeks. Decrease the heat source by 5
  degrees weekly until 50 degrees is reached.
- Button Quail need to remain in an environment above 50 degrees even as adults.
- Feed 18 30%-layer mash/crumble.
- With week old peeps crumble will need to be ground to a powder to minimize choking hazard.
- Maintain food and water source 24/7.
- Quail should be kept out of the wind.
- Enclosure does not need to be large, but does need a lid as button quail do fly

We sell live and frozen quail for feeders. Periodically our live quail are bought as a pet or in breeding clusters. These are live animals that we do stand by. We ask customers to call us with any issues. We will offer a one-time replacement on any pets if they become ill or die within one week of purchase.
